# PENZANCE

## COUNTY NOTES

The meeting of Truro City and St. Blazey in to-day's Senior Cup Final will recall memories of their last meeting in the final. Then it took three games to decide the winners—St. Blazey. Truro, in fact have not won the Senior Cup since 1938, but their hopes are very high to-day, for they are having a successful season, and in the semi-final of the South Western League Cup beat a strong Plymouth Argyle side 2-1.

St. Blazey, on the other hand, are the holders of the cup, and have won it four times since the war, and will make every effort to retain the trophy. Their form at the moment is very in and out, and they were eliminated from the Charity Cup by Launceston 1-3 at the same time that Truro were registering their win over Argyle. Nanpean, after coming so near to surprising everybody, find themselves in the runners-up game against Penzance. This should be a close game with a contrast in styles.

Of the other County Competitions the situation is, in the Charity Cup that Launceston, St. Austell and Newquay are through to the semi-finals, while Penzance played St. Just on Friday last and the result is now known. These semi-finals will be mid-week games.

In the Senior League Cup the finalists in Division I are Helston and Nanpean, and in Division II Mullion and Roche. The Junior Cup Finals are being played at Newquay on Saturday, April 4th next, kick-off 3 p.m. The finalists are Carbis Bay and Foxhole, and the runners-up Illogan British Legion and Camelford British Railways.

Once again the C.C.F.A. is grateful to the St. Austell Club and its Supporters' Club for their co-operation in to-day's arrangements.
